	Community Service	3 days per year for all, additional 2 days for Director and above.
	Bereavement	5 days for spouse, parent or child. 3 days for immediate family member and 1 day for extended family.
	Jury Duty	Employees summoned to serve will not be charged leave time for the time served on jury.
	Voting	Fahe allows sufficient time for employees who for good reason are unable to vote before or after their regularly scheduled work period.
